Merlot Reserva, Viña Echeverría / Valle de Curicó, Chile <i>From an awarded 'Sustainable Winery', with heritage back to the 1930s, these guys know their onions - and more importantly, their Merlot! Minervois, Caz Ailes, Château d'Agel/ Languedoc, France <i>Ripe black fruits, spice and a touch of black olive define this Southern French blend with a rich palate - happens to be organic too!</i>				36
Garnacha Blend, Sierra de Gata y Gredos, Vino de Montaña / Sierra de Gata, Spain <i>Called a Garnacha Blend as the other two grape varieties are unspellable and unpronounceable, unless you happen to be Spanish of course. That aside, the wine is soft and fruity with hints of spice and a fresh finish.</i>				38
Mourvèdre Illégal, Olivier Coste / Languedoc, France <i>A superb expression of Mourvèdre from the Languedoc, where wines made from 100% Mourvèdre are not permitted, hence it is 'Illégal' - rules really suck, but thankfully this wine doesn't. It's a fresh, dark, brooding beauty!</i>				40
Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Ondarre / Rioja, Spain <i>Plenty of dark berry fruit complemented by smooth richness from extended ageing in oak, delicious! Did you know the Welsh people are the largest consumers of Rioja in the UK? The challenge is set!</i>	7	9½	22	42

Pinot Noir Gran Reserva, Sibaris, Undurraga / Valle de Leyda, Chile <i>If you love the soft, rich, medium-weight style of properly made Pinot Noir, then this is the wine for you, with elegance and style, and such great value!</i>				46
Primitivo di Manduria, Talò, San Marzano / Puglia, Italy <i>Primitivo has the same grape DNA as Zinfandel, but don't let that put you off. This is from an award-winning cooperative in Puglia, southern Italy, and has a wonderful, rich and fruity style, softness and depth, and a fair chunk of alcohol too!</i>				48
Souson, Ribeiro, Ailalá / Galicia, Spain <i>Souson is the native grape variety from this part of northwestern Spain, and Ailala is the local word that equates to "Olé" - a cry of joy and fun, which is exactly what the wine gives your tastebuds!</i>				50
Côtes du Rhône, Saint Cosme / Rhône, France <i>An inky-black wine made exclusively from Syrah, very unusual for a CDR. Blackcurrant, truffle, liquorice and wild raspberry to tickle your fancy!</i>				54
Crozes-Hermitage Rouge Les Jalets, Paul Jaboulet Aîné / Rhône, France <i>Les Jalets are the 'pebbles' reminiscent of those found in Châteauneuf, but unlike Châteauneuf, this wine features 100% Syrah, with intensity, style, finesse and the pedigree of one of the greatest producers of wine in the world, Paul Jaboulet.</i>				65
Saint-Émilion Grand Cru / Bordeaux, France <i>A chunk of Cabernet Franc injects interest and depth into this otherwise classic St. Émilion, with earthy, cedar and tobacco notes.</i>				68
Amarone della Valpolicella, Ca'Rugate / Veneto, Italy <i>A big, bold and beautiful wine, with serious intensity whilst remaining balanced and elegant - a show-stopper for sure!</i>				75
