<i>When only Champagne will do, Palmer & Co is a charming collaboration between seven grape growers who only farm Premier Cru and Grand Cru grapes. Extended ageing gives this exceptional cuvée outstanding complexity and finesse.</i>		
Champagne Dom Perignon / Champagne, France		250
<i>Dom Pérignon is a prestigious vintage Champagne, known for its elegant and complex flavour profile, made from a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes, and aged for at least 7 years before release.</i>

<i>It might sound like something you don't want to catch, but trust us, the only thing you definitely will catch is the aroma of pineapple, vanilla and pear, and a luscious mouthful with a long creamy finish!</i>				
Lugana, Le Civaie Terralbe, Monte Zovo / Lombardy, Italy				58
<i>It's hard to believe such a classy wine with elegance and poise such as this is not twice the price - you lucky people!</i>				
Saint-Véran Plaisance, Thierry Drouin / Burgundy, France				62
<i>Just a classic white Burgundy from right next door to Pouilly-Fuissé, without the P-F price-tag! Elegant mineral structure with oodles of citrus...</i>

<i>Juicy, pale rosé, with strawberry, citrus and orange peel aromas. Ample minerality as well as a medium-bodied and racy profile on the palate!</i>

Merlot Reserva, Viña Echeverría / Valle de Curicó, Chile	6	8	18	34
<i>From an awarded 'Sustainable Winery', with heritage back to the 1930s, these guys know their onions - and more importantly, their Merlot! Soft & rich with black and red fruits in abundance, and a little more weight, and some oak - great value!</i>				
Minervois, Caz Ailes, Château d'Agel/ Languedoc, France				36
<i>Ripe black fruits, spice and a touch of black olive define this Southern French blend with a rich palate - happens to be organic too!</i>				
Garnacha Blend, Sierra de Gata y Gredos, Vino de Montaña / Sierra de Gata, Spain				38
<i>Called a Garnacha Blend as the other two grape varieties are unspellable and unpronounceable, unless you happen to be Spanish of course. That aside, the wine is soft and fruity with hints of spice and a fresh finish.</i>				
Mourvèdre Illégal, Olivier Coste / Languedoc, France				40
<i>A superb expression of Mourvèdre from the Languedoc, where wines made from 100% Mourvèdre are not permitted, hence it is 'Illégal' - rules really suck, but thankfully this wine doesn't. It's a fresh, dark, brooding beauty!</i>				
Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Ondarre / Rioja, Spain	7	9½	22	42
<i>Plenty of dark berry fruit complemented by smooth richness from extended ageing in oak, delicious! Did you know the Welsh people are the largest consumers of Rioja in the UK? The challenge is set!</i>				
Moschomavro/Limnio, Exis, Manolesakis Estate / Macedonia, Greece	7¼	10¼	23	43
<i>It's all Greek to me, and that's just fine - plenty of ripe cherry & plum with hints of clove and cinnamon, sublime...</i>				
Vallado Tinto, Quinta do Vallado / Douro, Portugal				44
<i>If you like Port, then it's highly likely that you will like this, albeit in a slightly reduced intensity compared to Port, but still a full-bodied red with dried fruit character and obvious ripeness.</i>				
Malbec, 1300, Andeluna / Mendoza, Argentina	7½	10½	24	45
<i>Named after the altitude at which the vineyards are situated, this wine is classic, youthful Malbec - desperately seeking Susan, sorry, I mean steak!</i>				
Pinot Noir Gran Reserva, Sibaris, Undurraga / Valle de Leyda, Chile				46
<i>If you love the soft, rich, medium-weight style of properly made Pinot Noir, then this is the wine for you, with elegance and style, and such great value!</i>				
Primitivo di Manduria, Talò, San Marzano / Puglia, Italy				48
<i>Primitivo has the same grape DNA as Zinfandel, but don't let that put you off. This is from an award-winning cooperative in Puglia, southern Italy, and has a wonderful, rich and fruity style, softness and depth, and a fair chunk of alcohol too!</i>				
Souson, Ribeiro, Ailalá / Galicia, Spain				50
<i>Souson is the native grape variety from this part of northwestern Spain, and Ailala is the local word that equates to "Olé" - a cry of joy and fun, which is exactly what the wine gives your tastebuds!</i>				
Côtes du Rhône, Saint Cosme / Rhône, France				54
<i>An inky-black wine made exclusively from Syrah, very unusual for a CDR. Blackcurrant, truffle, liquorice and wild raspberry to tickle your fancy!</i>				
Crozes-Hermitage Rouge Les Jalets, Paul Jaboulet Aîné / Rhône, France				65
<i>Les Jalets are the 'pebbles' reminiscent of those found in Châteauneuf, but unlike Châteauneuf, this wine features 100% Syrah, with intensity, style, finesse and the pedigree of one of the greatest producers of wine in the world, Paul Jaboulet.</i>				
Saint-Émilion Grand Cru / Bordeaux, France				68
<i>A chunk of Cabernet Franc injects interest and depth into this otherwise classic St. Émilion, with earthy, cedar and tobacco notes.</i>				
Amarone della Valpolicella, Ca'Rugate / Veneto, Italy				75
<i>A big, bold and beautiful wine, with serious intensity whilst remaining balanced and elegant - a show-stopper for sure!</i>
